Introduction

This matter dealt with an application by the Tenant for the return of double the security deposit and for loss or damage under the Act, regulations or tenancy agreement.

The hearing started at 11:00 a.m. as scheduled. The Tenant's advocate phoned in and indicated she had just taken over the case so she required the Tenant's presents to continue. The Arbitrator and Advocate waited until 9:10 a.m. and neither the Tenant nor the Landlord dialled into the conference call. In the absence of any evidence from the Tenant to support the application, the application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

Conclusion

The Tenant's application is dismissed with leave to reapply.
