DECISION

Introduction

This telephone conference call hearing was convened as the result of the tenants' application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") seeking to dispute an additional rent increase, for an order requiring the landlord to comply with the Act, and for recovery of the filing fee.

The hearing began at 9:00 a.m. as scheduled and the telephone system remained open and was monitored for 16 minutes. During this time, neither the applicants/tenants nor the respondent/landlord dialed into the telephone conference call hearing.

Analysis and Conclusion

In the absence of the tenants to present their claim, pursuant to section 10.1 of the Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure (Rules), I dismiss the tenants' application, with leave to reapply.
