Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the tenant's application for dispute resolution seeking remedy under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act"). The tenant applied for an order authorizing the tenant to change the locks to the rental unit, and for "other", which is described as seeking an order restricting the landlord entry to the rental unit.

The tenant and the landlord attended the hearing. The tenant stated that he vacated the rental unit and as a result, requested to **withdraw his application in full**. Therefore, I make no findings on the merits of the tenant's application.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the *Act*, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
