DECISION

Introduction

This hearing was convened in response to cross-applications by the parties for dispute resolution, for Monetary Orders. The tenant filed on August 12, 2013 pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the Act) for Orders as follows:

- 1. An Order for return of security deposit Section 38
- 2. A monetary Order for loss Section 67

The landlord filed on October 09, 2013 for Orders as follows;

- 1. A monetary Order for damage / loss Section 67
- 2. A monetary Order for Unpaid rent section 67
- 3. An Order to retain the security deposit Section 38
- 4. An Order to recover the filing fee for this application (\$50) Section 72.

Both parties attended the hearing and were given opportunity to settle their dispute, ask questions, and present relevant evidence, and provide relevant testimony.

Analysis and conclusion

During the hearing the parties discussed their dispute and upon a period of deliberation on their applications before these proceedings, both parties confirmed they each determined to withdraw their respective applications for all time.

As a result of all the above, both applications are **withdrawn and effectively cancelled**, without liberty to reapply.
