AGREEMENT REACHED BETWEEN THE PARTIES

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MND, MNR

Introduction

This matter dealt with an application by the landlord for a Monetary Order for damage to the unit site or property and for unpaid rent or utilities.

Through the course of the hearing I assisted the parties in coming to an agreement in settlement of the landlord's application. The Parties did not require me to make a decision in this matter but required me to record the agreement they mutually reached.

This agreement is as follows:

- The tenant agrees to pay no less than \$100.00 per month until the outstanding amount of \$916.44 for utilities is settled. The first payment will be made on December 01, 2013;
- The landlord agrees to accept the payment plan proposed by the tenant;
- The landlord withdraws her application in its entirety.

Conclusion

Both Parties have reached an agreement during the hearing and this agreement has been recorded by the Arbitrator pursuant to section 62 of the *Act* in full, final and binding settlement of the landlord's application.

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If the tenants default on this agreement the landlord is at liberty to file a new application

for unpaid utilities.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential

Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
