Introduction

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution filed on November 21, 2013, by the Tenants to cancel a Notice to end tenancy for end of employment and to recover the cost of the filing fee from the Landlord for this application.

The parties appeared at the scheduled teleconference hearing.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Do the Tenants wish to proceed with their application?

Background and Evidence

At the outset of this the Tenant advised that they have secured another place to live and will be moving as soon as they are able to secure a moving truck. Therefore, she wished to withdraw her application for dispute resolution.

Analysis and Conclusion

The Tenants have withdrawn their application; therefore, no further action is required and the file is now closed.
