DECISION

Introduction

This hearing dealt with an application by the landlord pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act*, for a monetary order for loss of income and the filing fee. The landlord also applied to retain the security in partial satisfaction of the claim. Both parties attended the hearing and were given full opportunity to present evidence and make submissions.

Issues to be Decided

Is the landlord entitled to a monetary order?

Background and Evidence

The rental unit consists of a room in a home that is occupied by the landlord who is also the owner of the home. The landlord shares a kitchen the tenant.

Analysis

Based on the above facts I find that the tenant rented a room in the home of the owner/landlord and shared the kitchen with the owner/landlord. Section 4 of the *Residential Tenancy Act*, addresses what the *Act* does not apply to. It states that the *Act* does not apply to living accommodation in which the tenant shares bathroom or kitchen facilities with the owner of that accommodation

Conclusion

The circumstances of the dispute do not fall within the jurisdiction of the *Act*, and the application must therefore be dismissed. The landlord is at liberty to pursue other remedies under common law.
