Introduction

This hearing was scheduled in response to the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant applied to set aside a Notice to End Tenancy for Cause and for an Order requiring the Landlord to comply with the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)* and the tenancy agreement.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Should the Notice to End Tenancy be set aside and is there a need to issue an Order requiring the Landlord to comply with the *Act* and the tenancy agreement?

Background and Evidence

The hearing was scheduled for 1:00 p.m. on this date and by 1:11 p.m. the Agent for the Landlord had appeared, but the Tenant had not.

<u>Analysis</u>

I find that the Tenant failed to diligently pursue the application and I therefore dismiss the application without leave to reapply.
