DECISION

Introduction

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 11:00 a.m., in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution made by the landlord to obtain an Order of Possession for unpaid rent or utilities and for cause. The landlord also applied for a Monetary Order for unpaid rent or utilities and to recover the cost of this application from the tenant.

The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time.

Analysis & Conclusion

As neither party called into the conference call by 11:10 a.m., I dismiss this application with leave to reapply. However, this does not extend any applicable time limits under the *Residential Tenancy Act*. I have made no findings of fact or law with respect to the merits of this application.
