SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MND MNSD FF

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the landlord's monetary claim. The landlord, the tenant and the tenant's agent participated in the teleconference hearing.

Settlement Agreement

During the hearing, the parties agreed to settle this matter, on the following conditions:

- 1) the landlord agrees to withdraw his application;
- 2) the landlord may retain \$400 from the security and pet deposits;
- 3) the landlord will pay the tenant \$1400, representing return of the balance of the security and pet deposits; and
- 4) in consideration for this mutual settlement the parties agree that no further claims will be made by either party whatsoever arising from this tenancy.

Conclusion

I grant the tenant an order under section 67 for the balance due of \$1400. This order may be filed in the Small Claims Court and enforced as an order of that Court.

This settlement agreement was reached in accordance with section 63 of the Residential Tenancy Act.
