## **DECISION**

## <u>Introduction</u>

This was the hearing of an application by the landlord for an order for possession and a monetary order On October 9, 2013 the landlord was granted an order for possession and a monetary order for unpaid rent. The tenant applied to review the original decision and orders. Her application for review consideration was denied in a decision dated October 21, 2013.

## Conclusion

The landlord has applied for an order for possession and a monetary order for unpaid rent. The application was filed on October 28, 2013. The matters raised by the landlord's application for dispute resolution are *res judicata;* that is they have already been decided by the decision dated October 9, 2013. The landlord is seeking a duplicate of orders already granted to him. It is up to the landlord to enforce the decision and orders granted on October 9, 2013 rather than pursuing a second application for the same relief. The application is therefore dismissed without leave to reapply.
