Introduction and Analysis

This hearing was convened to deal with the landlord's application for dispute resolution under the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act") for an order of possession for the rental unit and a monetary order for unpaid rent.

The landlord appeared; the tenant did not appear. The landlord stated that the tenant did not claim her registered mail package containing his application and Notice of Hearing.

At the outset of the hearing, the landlord confirmed that the tenant has now vacated the rental unit; the landlord confirmed that he no longer required an order of possession for the rental unit and that he did not want to pursue a monetary claim.

The landlord agreed that his application should be withdrawn.

Conclusion

As the landlord requested withdrawal of his application and cancellation of the hearing, I grant this request, having made no findings of fact or law, and his application is hereby withdrawn.
