## DECISION

### Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the landlord's application for dispute resolution seeking remedy under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "*Act*"). The landlord applied for a monetary order for money owed or compensation for damage or loss under the *Act*, regulation or tenancy agreement, to recover the filing fee, and "other" although details of "other" were not provided in the landlord's application. The landlord writes that they are seeking \$1,381.00 for the cost of bailiff fees, plus the filing fee.

The tenants did not attend the hearing. An agent for the landlord (the "agent") did attend the hearing, and requested to **withdraw the landlord's application in full**. Therefore, I make no findings on the merits of the matter.

The landlord is at liberty to reapply. This decision does not extend any applicable time limits under the *Act*.

This decision is final and binding on the parties, unless otherwise provided under the *Act*, and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
