Introduction:

This hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant applied for the return of the security deposit and to recover the fee for filing this Application for Dispute Resolution.

Issue(s) to be Decided:

Is the Tenant entitled to the return of the security deposit?

Background and Evidence:

This hearing was scheduled for 9:00 a.m. on April 30, 2014 and by 9:12 a.m. the Landlord had appeared, but the Tenant had not appeared.

<u>Analysis</u>

I find that the Tenant failed to diligently pursue the application and I therefore dismiss the application <u>without leave to reapply.</u>
