RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> CNC, MT

Section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows;

 Both parties agree that they have resolved the matter outside of this hearing and that tenancy is to continue and that the One Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause dated May 24, 2014 with an effective date of July 2, 2014 be set aside.

The above particulars comprise <u>full and final settlement</u> of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application for both parties.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
