<u>Introduction</u>

In response to an application by the landlord this hearing was scheduled to commence by way of telephone conference call at 9:30 a.m. on August 05, 2014. The tenants were present at that time. However, as the landlord had still not appeared by 9:40 a.m. the call was ended. In the result, the landlord's application is hereby dismissed.

Arising from the tenants' inquiry about the disposition of the security deposit, the attention of the parties is drawn to section 38 of the Act which addresses **Return of security deposit and pet damage deposit**.
