DECISION

This matter was scheduled for a conference call at 9:30 a.m. Both parties participated in teleconference. After hearing from both parties it became clear that the owner of the property and the tenant were sharing a bathroom and kitchen facility. Section 4 of the *Residential Tenancy Act*, addresses what the *Act* does not apply to. It states that the *Act* does not apply to living accommodation in which the tenant shares bathroom or kitchen facilities with the owner of that accommodation

Following careful consideration of the full circumstances of this dispute, I find that the circumstances of the dispute do not fall within the jurisdiction of the *Act*, and the application must therefore be dismissed. The tenant is at liberty to pursue other remedies under common law.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
