DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant to cancel a 1 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Cause, issued July 28, 2014.

Both parties appeared. During the hearing the parties agreed to settle this matter on the following conditions:

- 1) The parties agreed to mutually end the tenancy effective November 30, 2014; and
- 2) The parties agreed the landlord is entitled to an order of possession effective on the above noted date.

This settlement agreement was reached in accordance with section 63 of the Residential Tenancy Act.

Conclusion

As a result of the above settlement, the landlord is granted an order of possession.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
