## **DECISION**

<u>Dispute Codes</u> CNR, OPR, MNR, MDSD & FF

## <u>Introduction</u>

Neither party contacted the telephone bridge. The telephone line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes. Neither party appeared. I then concluded the hearing and closed the conference call.

Rule 10.1 of the Rules of Procedure provides as follows:

## 10.1 Commencement of the dispute resolution proceeding

The dispute resolution proceeding must commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise decided by the arbitrator. The arbitrator may conduct the dispute resolution proceeding in the absence of a party and may make a decision or dismiss the application, with or without leave to re-apply.

Accordingly, in the absence of any evidence or submissions I order the application dismissed filed by each party be dismissed with liberty to reapply. I make no findings on the merits of the matter. Liberty to reapply is not an extension of any applicable limitation period.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
