Introduction

This matter was conducted by way of Direct Request Proceeding, pursuant to section 55(4) of the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the Act). The landlord applied for an order of possession and a monetary order for unpaid rent.

Preliminary Issues

The landlord submitted a tenancy agreement that was signed by the tenant but not dated, and was not signed by the landlord. The landlord also submitted unclear evidence regarding payments of rent and a document which included the notation "monetary order obtained Hearing Oct 20th." Because the landlord has provided incomplete, unclear evidence, I find that this matter is not appropriate for the Direct Request process.

Conclusion

The application is dismissed with leave to reapply.
