Introduction
This hearing was scheduled in response to the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant applied to set aside a Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent.
Issue(s) to be Decided
Should the Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent be set aside?
Background and Evidence
The hearing was scheduled for 2:30 p.m. on this date. The Landlord dialed into the teleconference at the scheduled start time but by 2:42 p.m. the Tenant had not yet appeared.
<u>Analysis</u>
I find that the Tenant failed to diligently pursue the application and I therefore dismiss the application without leave to reapply.
