<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant to cancel a Ten-Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent or Utilities.

The applicant/tenant did not appear, but the respondent/ landlord was present.

As the tenant did not appear, I find that the tenant's application requesting an order to cancel the Ten-Day Notice must be dismissed.

At the hearing the respondent/landlord stated that the parties have entered into a payment plan since the 10-Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent had been issued.

The tenant's application to cancel the 10-Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent is hereby dismissed without leave.

Conclusion

The tenant's application is dismissed without leave to reapply.
