### **DECISION**

Introduction

This was a hearing with respect to the landlord's application for an order for possession and a monetary order. The hearing was conducted by conference call. The landlord called in and was represented by her realtor, who also acted as the translator for the landlord.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Is the landlord entitled to an order for possession? Is the landlord entitled to a monetary award for unpaid rent?

### Background and Evidence

The landlord submitted an application for dispute resolution on November 3, 2014, seeking an order for possession and a monetary order in the amount of \$700.00. The landlord did not submit any documentary evidence in support of her application and did not provide proof that the tenant was served with the application for dispute resolution and Notice of Hearing.

### **Conclusion**

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In the absence of proof of service upon the tenant and in the absence of any documentary evidence from the landlord this application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
