DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This matter dealt with an application by the Tenant to cancel a Notice to End Tenancy for Cause and to recover the filing fee for this proceeding.

The hearing stared at 11:00 a.m. as scheduled, however by 11:10 a.m. the Tenant had not dialled into the conference call. In the absence of any evidence from the Tenant to support the application, the application is dismissed without leave to reapply.

The Landlord requested an Order of Possession for December 31, 2014, which is the effective vacancy date on the Notice to End Tenancy.

Conclusion

The Tenants' application is dismissed without leave to reapply.

An Order of Possession effective December 31, 2014 has been issued to the Landlord. A copy of the Order must be served on the Tenant in accordance with the Act: the Order of Possession and may be enforced in the Supreme Court of British Columbia
