Introduction

This hearing was convened in response to the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant applied to set aside a Notice to End Tenancy for Cause and to recover the fee for filing this Application.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Should the Notice to End Tenancy for Cause, served pursuant to section 47 of the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)*, be set aside?

Background and Evidence

The female Tenant stated that the Tenant is withdrawing the Application for Dispute Resolution, as the Tenant does not wish the tenancy to continue and, therefore, no longer wishes to dispute the Notice to End Tenancy.

Analysis
