A matter regarding WALL FINANCIAL CORPORATION and [tenant name suppressed to protect privacy]

DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> OPR, MNR, MNSD, FF

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the Act) for:

- an order of possession for unpaid rent pursuant to section 55;
- a monetary order for unpaid rent pursuant to section 67;
- authorization to retain all or a portion of the tenant's security deposit in partial satisfaction of the monetary order requested pursuant to section 38; and
- authorization to recover its filing fee for this application from the tenant pursuant to section 72.

The landlord's agent attended at the hearing at the designated time.

At the hearing, the agent stated that the tenant's arrears had been paid in full and it was the landlord's intent to continue the tenancy. The agent asked to withdraw the landlord's application.

As there is no prejudice to the tenant by allowing the landlord to withdraw it application, I allowed it.

The landlord's application is withdrawn.
