FF <u>Introduction</u> The hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Landlord has applied for an Order of Possession for Cause and to recover the fee for filing this Application for Dispute Resolution. Issue(s) to be Decided Is the Landlord entitled to an Order of Possession pursuant to section 55 of the Residential Tenancy Act (Act)? Background and Evidence At the outset of the hearing the Landlord withdrew the Application for Dispute Resolution, as the rental unit has been vacated. Analysis I find this Application for Dispute Resolution has been withdrawn.
