Introduction

This hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the Tenant applied for an Order requiring the Landlord to comply with the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)*, for a monetary Order for money owed or compensation for damage or loss, and to recover the fee for filing this application.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Is there a need for an Order requiring the Landlord to comply with the *Residential Tenancy Act (Act)* or the tenancy agreement? Is the entitled to a monetary Order?

Background and Evidence

The hearing was scheduled to begin at 1:00 p.m. on May 19, 2015. When I dialed into the teleconference at 1:02 p.m. the Landlord was in attendance, but the Tenant was not. I monitored the teleconference until 1:12 p.m. By the time the teleconference was ended at 1:12 p.m., the Tenant had not appeared.

Analysis

I find that the Tenant failed to diligently pursue the application and I therefore dismiss the Application for Dispute Resolution without leave to reapply.

Conclusion
