## **DECISION**

Dispute Codes DRI

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") to dispute a rent increase pursuant to section 43 of the Act.

The tenant appeared at the designated time. At the commencement of the hearing, the tenant indicated that he and the landlord had reached a resolution of the dispute. The tenant asked to cancel his application. I confirmed with the tenant that he sought to withdraw his application. The tenant confirmed that this was his intent.

As there is no prejudice to the landlord by allowing the tenant to withdraw his application, I allowed it.

The tenant's application is withdrawn.
