## DECISION

Dispute Codes CNL, OLC

Introduction

A This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant filed under the Residential Tenancy Act, (the "Act"), to cancel a 2 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use of Property.

Both parties appeared.

## Preliminary matter

At the outset of the hearing the tenant stated that they did not receive a notice to end the tenancy. The tenant stated that they have moved out of the property.

The respondent's agent indicated applicant is not a tenant under the Act.

In the case, before me the tenant is seeking an order to cancel a notice to end tenancy that was never issued. Further, the tenant has vacated the premises. As a result, I find there are no issues to be determined at today's hearing.

Although the respondent's agent indicated that the applicant is not a tenant under the Act. I find there is no requirement for me to determine that at today's hearing as I have found there are no issues to be considered.

## **Conclusion**

The tenant's application is dismissed
