A matter regarding BRISTOL ESTATES and [tenant name suppressed to protect privacy] **DECISION**

<u>Dispute Codes</u> OPL, MNR, MNSD, FF

Introduction

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("*Act*") for:

- an Order of Possession for landlord's use of property, pursuant to section 55;
- a monetary order for unpaid rent, pursuant to section 67;
- authorization to retain all or a portion of the tenant's security deposit in partial satisfaction of the monetary order requested, pursuant to section 38; and
- authorization to recover the filing fee for this application from the tenants, pursuant to section 72.

The landlord's agent, DS ("landlord") and one of the two tenants, CK ("tenant"), attended the hearing and were each given a full opportunity to be heard, to present sworn testimony, to make submissions, and to call witnesses.

At the outset of the hearing, the landlord testified that she wished to withdraw the landlord's entire application, as the matter had been resolved. The tenant confirmed that the matter had been resolved. Accordingly, the landlord's application is withdrawn.

Conclusion

The landlord's entire application is withdrawn.
