<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was scheduled in response to the landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the landlord has requested to retain the security deposit and to recover the filing fee from the tenant for the cost of this Application for Dispute Resolution.

The details of the dispute section of the application indicated a claim for damage.

The dispute resolution proceeding must commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise decided by the arbitrator. The arbitrator may conduct the dispute resolution proceeding in the absence of a party and may make a decision or dismiss the application, with or without leave to re-apply.

In the absence of an appearance by either party by 1:42 p.m., this application is abandoned and dismissed with leave to reapply.
