DECISION

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("the *Act*") for a monetary order for unpaid rent pursuant to section 67 and authorization to recover the filing fee for this application from the tenant pursuant to section 72.

The tenant did not attend this hearing, although this teleconference hearing scheduled for 1:30 pm continued until 1:44 pm. The landlord's representative attended the hearing. She acknowledged that she did not have the details or any proof of service with respect to the service of her Application for Dispute Resolution package to the landlord available as evidence at this point in time.
