<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing convened pursuant to the tenant's application to cancel a notice to end tenancy, as well as to dispute an additional rent increase. The tenant and the landlord called in to the teleconference hearing.

Preliminary Issue

The tenant stated that he had moved out of the rental unit. It was therefore not necessary for me to consider the notice to end tenancy. The tenant stated that he seeks reimbursement for overpayment of rent, and I informed the tenant that he can apply for monetary compensation. The landlord stated that the tenant had damaged the rental unit, and I informed her that the landlord may also file an application.

Conclusion

The tenant's application is dismissed.
