Introduction

This hearing was convened in response to an Application for Dispute Resolution by the tenant for compensation under the Residential Tenancy Act (the Act) and to recover the filing fee.

The applicant tenant was provided with a copy of the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing after filing their application dated April 17, 2015. The tenant, however, did not attend the hearing set for today at 1:30 p.m. The phone line remained open for ten minutes and was monitored throughout this time. The only parties to call into the hearing were the respondent landlord and their realtor in support.

Analysis and Conclusion

Following the ten minute waiting period, the application of the tenant was dismissed, without leave to reapply.

This Decision is final and binding on both parties.
