## RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

Dispute Codes MNR, OPR, MND, MNDC, FF, MNSD, OPB

Section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows;

- 1. Both parties agree that the landlord will retain the \$1200.00 security deposit.
- 2. Both parties agree that they will not seek any further monetary claims or file any further applications in regards to this tenancy.

The above particulars comprise <u>full and final settlement</u> of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application for both parties.
