Introduction and Analysis

This Hearing was scheduled to hear the Tenant's application for an Order that the Landlord comply with the Act; and for return of the security deposit.

This application was scheduled to be heard via teleconference on December 10, 2015, at 1:30 p.m. By 1:45 p.m., neither party had signed into the teleconference.

The Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure provide that the Hearing must commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise decided by the arbitrator. The arbitrator may conduct the hearing in the absence of a party and may make a decision or dismiss the application, with or without leave to re-apply.

As neither party attended the conference, I dismiss the Tenant's application with leave to re-apply. This does not extend any existing time limits that may apply.

Conclusion

The Tenant's application is dismissed **with leave to re-apply**. This does not extend any existing time limits that may apply.
