<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened to hear matters pertaining to an Application for Dispute Resolution filed by the Tenant on October 30, 2015. The Tenant filed seeking an order to allow her to change the locks to her rental unit. The hearing was conducted via teleconference and was attended by the Tenant. No one was in attendance on behalf of the Landlord.

Issue(s) to be Decided

Does the Tenant wish to proceed with her application as filed?

Background, Evidence and Analysis

The Tenant appeared and provided affirmed testimony that she has recently been issued a do not attend and no contact order from Provincial Court.

Upon further clarification the Tenant testified that she was no longer seeking to obtain an Order to change the locks on the rental unit. Accordingly, her application will be considered withdrawn.
