RECORD OF SETTLEMENT

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MNR, MNSD, FF, MNDC, MND

Section 63 of the *Residential Tenancy Act* provides that the parties may attempt to settle their dispute during a hearing. Pursuant to this provision, discussion between the parties during the hearing led to a resolution. Specifically, it was agreed as follows;

- 1. Both parties agreed to abandon their applications.
- 2. Both parties agreed that they would not seek any further monetary claims under the Residential Tenancy Act in regards to this tenancy.

Both parties have benefitted from this settlement so they must each bear the cost of the filing fee.

The above particulars comprise <u>full and final settlement</u> of all aspects of the dispute arising from this application for both parties.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
