DECISION

<u>Dispute Codes</u> MT, CNR

<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the tenants' Application for Dispute Resolution seeking more time to cancel a notice to end tenancy and to cancel a notice to end tenancy.

The hearing was conducted via teleconference and was unattended.

Issue(s) to be Decided

The issues to be decided are whether the tenants are entitled to more time to cancel a notice to end tenancy and to cancel a 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent, pursuant to Sections 46 and 66 of the Residential Tenancy Act (Act).

Should the tenants be unsuccessful in seeking to cancel the 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent it must also be decided if the landlord is entitled to an order of possession pursuant to Section 55(1) of the *Act*.

Conclusion

In the absence of the applicant tenants, I dismiss this Application for Dispute Resolution in its entirety.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
