Introduction

This is an application for an Order of Possession based on a mutual agreement to end the tenancy; however, at the beginning of the conference call, the applicant stated that he already has an Order of Possession from a previous hearing that was held due to the tenant's failure to pay rent.

<u>Analysis</u>

As stated above an Order of Possession is no longer required as the landlord was already issued an Order of Possession for a different reason; however since his application was filed prior to the tenants failure to pay rent I will allow recovery of the landlords filing fee.

Conclusion

I have issued a monetary order in the amount of \$100.00.
