<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with an Application for Dispute Resolution by the landlord for an order of possession.

The applicant landlord was provided with a copy of the Notice of a Dispute Resolution Hearing after filing their application dated July 20, 2016. The landlord, however, did not attend the hearing set for today at 11:00 a.m. The phone line remained open for no less than ten minutes and was monitored throughout this time. The only party to call into the hearing was the tenant. The tenant stated they vacated at the end of July 2016.

Analysis and Conclusion

Following the ten minute waiting period, the application of the landlord was **dismissed**, without leave to reapply.

This Decision is final and binding on both parties.
