## **DECISION**

Dispute Codes RP, RR

## <u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the tenant's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act") for:

- an order to the landlord to make repairs to the rental unit pursuant to section 32;
   and
- an order to allow the tenant to reduce rent for repairs, services or facilities agreed upon but not provided, pursuant to section 65.

The tenant and landlord attended the hearing and were each given a full opportunity to be heard, to present affirmed testimony, to make submissions and to call witnesses.

At the outset of the hearing the tenant testified that she had vacated the rental unit on August 13, 2016. As the tenancy is ended and as a landlord's compliance may only be sought in relation to an ongoing tenancy I dismiss the tenant's claim in its entirety.

## Conclusion

I dismiss the tenant's entire application without leave to reapply.
