<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing dealt with the landlord's application pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act* ("the *Act*") for a monetary order for unpaid rent or other loss pursuant to section 67 and authorization to recover the filing fee from the tenants pursuant to section 72.

Preliminary Issue

At this hearing, both parties attended. The tenant testified that he had not yet received the landlord/applicant's evidentiary materials. The landlord provided some evidence that she had been under a doctor's care and therefore had been unable to submit her evidence in time for this hearing. She requested to withdraw her application. In these circumstances, given the evidence regarding the landlord's inability to prepare materials due to health reasons, I allowed the landlord to withdraw her application at this time.

Conclusion

The landlord's application is withdrawn.
