<u>Introduction</u>

This hearing was convened as a result of the Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, dated August 11, 2016 (the "Application").

Pursuant to the *Residential Tenancy Act*, the Tenant applied for an order cancelling a 10 Day Notice to End Tenancy for Unpaid Rent or Utilities, dated August 6, 2016 (the "10 Day Notice"), and other unspecified relief.

This matter was set for hearing by telephone conference call at 9:00 A.M. (Pacific Time) on October 3, 2016. The line remained open while the phone system was monitored for ten minutes and no participant called into the hearing during this time. Therefore, as the Applicant did not attend the hearing by 9:10 A.M., I dismiss the claim with leave to reapply. This is not an extension of any statutory deadline.
