### Introduction

This hearing was scheduled in response to the landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution, in which the landlord has requested compensation for unpaid rent.

Residential Tenancy Branch Rules of Procedure provides:

#### ***7.1 Commencement of the dispute resolution hearing***

*The dispute resolution hearing will commence at the scheduled time unless otherwise set by the arbitrator.*

#### ***7.3 Consequences of not attending the hearing***

*If a party or their agent fails to attend the hearing, the arbitrator may conduct the dispute resolution hearing in the absence of that party, or dismiss the application, with or without leave to re-apply.*

In the absence of an appearance of either party by 1:42 p.m. this application is abandoned and dismissed with leave to reapply within the legislated time-limit.

### Conclusion

The application is dismissed with leave to reapply.

This decision is final and binding and is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
