DECISION

Dispute Codes AAT, CNL, FF, LAT, MNDC, MT, OPT, RR

Introduction

The Application for Dispute Resolution filed by the Tenant seeks the following:

- a. An order to cancel a 2 month the one month Notice to End Tenancy
- b. A monetary order in the sum of \$25,000
- c. An order for the return of the Tenant's personal property
- d. An order to obtain a Tenant's Order for Possession
- e. An order to allow access to the unit for the Tenant or the tenant's guests
- f. An order authorizing the Tenant to change the locks
- g. An order allowing the tenant to reduce rent for repairs, services or facilities agreed ;upon but not provided
- h. An order to recover the cost of the filing fee.

Neither party contacted the telephone bridge number at the scheduled start of the hearing. The telephone line conference line remained open and the phone system was monitored for ten minutes. Neither party appeared. I then concluded the hearing and closed the conference call.

In the absence of any evidence or submissions I order the application dismissed with liberty to reapply. I make no findings on the merits of the matter. Liberty to reapply is not an extension of any applicable limitation period.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under section 9.1(1) of the Residential Tenancy Act.
