Introduction and Conclusion

This hearing convened as a result of a Tenant's Application for Dispute Resolution, filed October 11, 2016, wherein the Tenant sought an Order cancelling a 2 Month Notice to End Tenancy for Landlord's Use issued on September 22, 2016 (the "Notice") and to recover the filing fee.

Only the Tenant and her assistant, W.C., called into the hearing. A letter received by the Branch on October 25, 2016 confirms the Landlord's counsel was aware of the hearing and intended to appear on the Landlord's behalf.

The Tenant advised that on November 1, 2016 she moved from the rental unit such that her application to cancel the Notice was no longer required. Accordingly, her application is noted as withdrawn.
