Introduction

This hearing was convened as a result of the landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution (the "Application") seeking remedy under the *Residential Tenancy Act* (the "Act"). The landlord applied for an order of possession based on the tenants' notice to end tenancy, for a monetary order for damages to the unit, site or property, and to recover the cost of the filing fee.

The tenants did not attend the hearing. The landlord did attend the hearing, and requested to **withdraw her application in full**. Therefore, I make no findings on the merits of this matter. The landlord is at liberty to reapply. This decision does not extend any applicable time limits under the *Act*.

The landlord's Application was withdrawn in full.
