DECISION

Dispute Codes

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This hearing dealt with the Landlord's Application for Dispute Resolution, received at the Residential Tenancy Branch on January 3, 2017 (the "Application"). The Landlord applied for the following relief pursuant to the Residential Tenancy Act (the "Act"):

- an order granting recovery of the filing fee; and
- other unspecified relief.

The Landlord was represented at the hearing by A.H., an agent. The Tenant attended the hearing and was represented by M.C., his legal counsel.

At the outset of the hearing, A.H. advised that the Landlord wished to withdraw the Application as the Landlord and the Tenant have come to an agreement. On behalf of the Tenant, M.C. concurred. I grant the Landlord's request and I consider the Application withdrawn.

This decision is made on authority delegated to me by the Director of the Residential Tenancy Branch under Section 9.1(1) of the *Residential Tenancy Act*.
